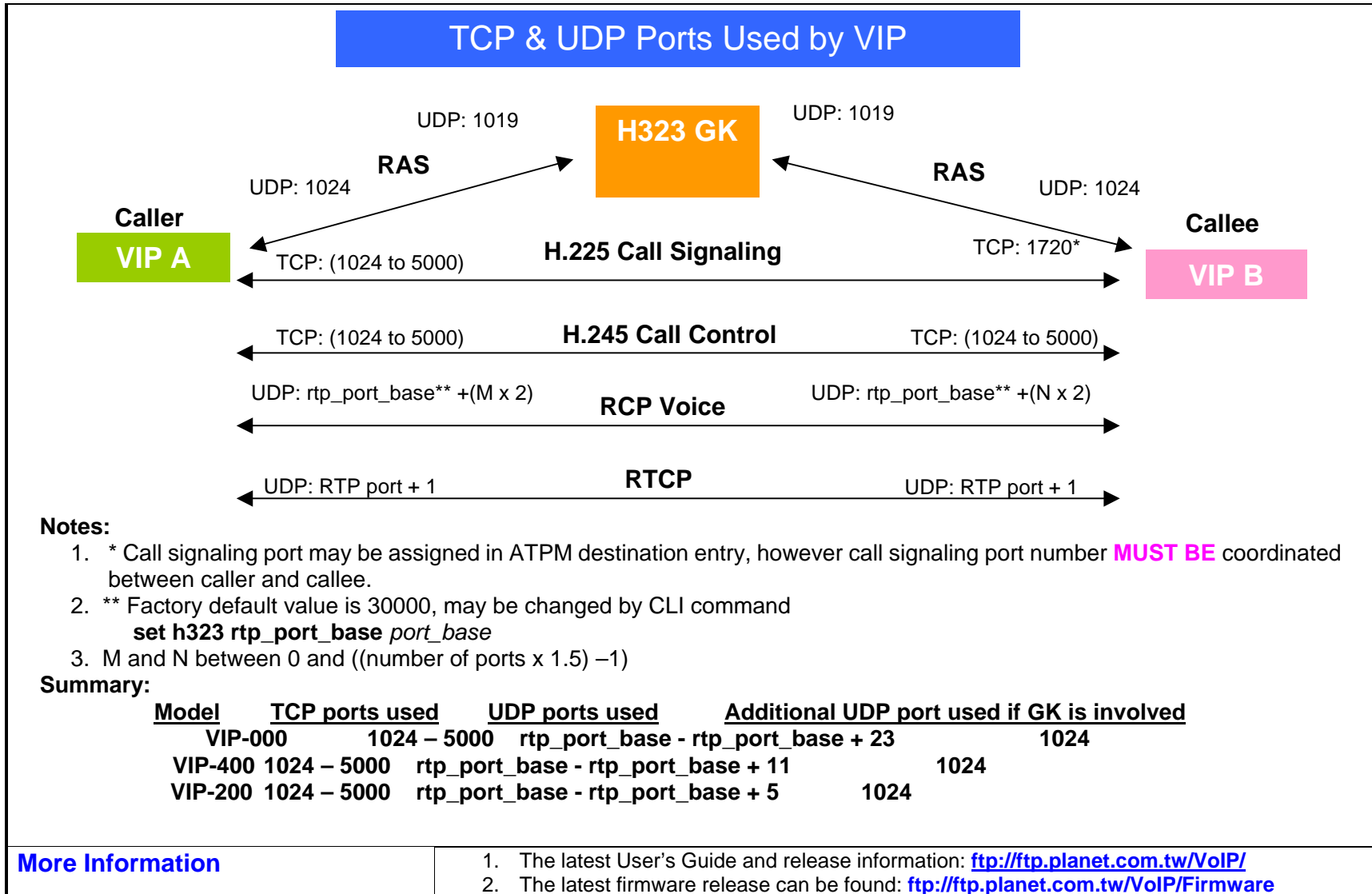

<b>Requirement</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. VIP-000 / 200 / 400 (firmware version must be 3.15 or above in order to have port assignment functionality)</li><li>2. A PC with terminal software (e.g. MS HyperTerminal) installed for command line interface operation</li></ol>		
<b>Interpretation</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Based on ITU-T H.323 standard, the port number which the H.225 listens for incoming call setup request is TCP port 1720. Previous firmware releases do not allow users to change this port number. To meet more various Internet applications, VIP series firmware release 3.15 now allows user to select the TCP port number, which listens for incoming H.225 call setup.</li></ol>
